Golf Tournament

The Golf tournament is firmly scheduled for 09 October and will be held at Blue Mash golf course. We have a \$500 deposit due. Our goal is to earn \$10,000 and in order to achieve that, we must have sponsorships! The tournament is capped at 132 individuals (33 4-person teams). The website will cost \$300, and must be paid before it can go live. There is a golf committee meeting scheduled for Wednesday, 01 May at 7 pm to be held at Dana's house.

Program Instructor's Report:

There will be a wreath laying, awards ceremony, and change of command ceremony at 9 am on Thursday, 23 May. A picnic will follow. There are 15 seniors, 7 of whom are already in military service or under contract to military service.
